## Strategies used to make people aware and to urge them to do something:

- 1 Greeting
- 2 Catching the attention of the audience by: asking a question / telling an anecdote / citing a quote or a proverb / giving statistics
- 3 -Functions in focus: warning / opinion / advice / suggestion /
- 4 -Emphatic forms: s + do / does / did / + v (bare infinitive)
- 5 -imperative form

In the long run you'll see that ... If I were you I would ... It's high time we .... + Past If only you were ... Beware of ... Not only will you ... but also ... I hope I'm getting though to all of you / thank you for your time.
